**Special guests Q & A:**

Dr. Lucero seeks to create a board of 23 members that will serve a finance committee with herself (representing every school)- monthly meeting (during budget season may be more than once)

Questions about changes to Healthy Food Choice -HFC-

Essentially there appear to be new rules going into effect that prohibit the sale of (non-healthy) food at any school-sponsored event, even after school hours. Uncertain exactly what the policy states, Tamu stated that she would review rules and policies and to see if it can be amended. Tamu: "I will help you advocate but i want to encourage alternate fundraisers". also suggested taking the passion from meeting to BOF/ BOR meetings

There had been specific instances of money not going directly to student-centered activity, as the policy had stated. Affects all, but particular concerns from high school parents.

Clarify the policy

Address parent frustrations and concerns (frustrations from parents about losing opportunity for food sales due to changing rules. parents feel tapped out, other ways to fundraise (girls running club)
